St. Peter's is a Church of England School with a Nursery, which is part of a wider Christian family. The Nursery and School benefit from strong links with the local parish church of St Peter's Walworth, and the support of the Southwark Diocesan Board of Education (SDBE).

At St. Peter's we believe that the successful partnership between the school, the church, the parents and the children helps each child to take full advantage of all that the school has to offer. The following agreement supports this partnership in the interests of our children.

Together we will

As a School we will.....

- Provide a balanced and appropriate curriculum for all children from Nursery to Year 6.
- Provide focused activities suitable for children's ages and abilities, which helps them progress.
- Establish a code of behaviour to ensure a safe and caring environment.
- Provide effective means of communication between the school and home.
- Monitor the progress of children and provide advice and guidance over their learning.
- Provide suitable books, which can be used at home.
- Encourage parents to be fully involved in all aspects of their children's learning and in the life of the school.

As a parent/guardian I will.....

- Give permission for my child's photo to be used in school publications (ie advertising, website, brochures etc). Pupil names will never placed under an image (*Pl inform the Head if you do not give permission for the use of your child's image*)
- Inform the school / nursery of any concerns about my child.
- Regularly attend parents' meetings to review my child's progress.
- Support the school rules and expectations as set out in the Behaviour Support Policy.
- Ensure that my child attends School / Nursery regularly, on time and with everything s/he needs. (Parents do not have a right to take their children on holiday during term time).
- Ensure any books are returned as and when requested.
- Ensure my child wears appropriate uniform and flat shoes.
- Encourage my child to take part in the full life of the school including ensuring attendance at off-site events, church services and extra-curricular activities.
- Contribute to the upkeep of the school building by paying £30 per academic year (voluntary)
- Make a positive contribution to the life of the school, helping with events, fund raising etc
